this time, we are currently supporting 13 families, both currently in the program as well as graduate families.

87% of those families needing assistance have become unemployed and are not yet receiving unemployment funds. As a result, our operating costs have significantly increased, as the families still need food, supplies and gasoline.

Our projected program expenses due to the pandemic are expected to increase by \$20,000.
