- Family Promise served 48 families in 2019 through our Emergency Shelter Program and Short-term Housing Program
 - Participating congregations provided 4,102 nights of shelter and served 12,306 meals
- In addition to our Emergency Shelter Program and Short-term Housing Program:
 - We provided supportive services to several of our graduates
 - We paid motel costs for several families who were living in parks
- We are proud that:
 - 80% of our families who graduated in 2019 obtained permanent housing
 - We maintained an 84% utilization rate in our Emergency Shelter
 - Four more of our families are getting housing in the next few weeks
